Green Team 2018-2019 wrap-up

-Cardboard recycling at SEAS was implemented in December 2018 and continues to be picked up weekly.

-Paper recycling through the Paper Gator program continues as well. Minimum rebates are received by the church quarterly from this program.

-Food Rescue has been extremely successfully this school year. In October 2018, we acquired two refrigerators for storing collected food items for a few days and started making twice a week deliveries to Charis House (Fort Wayne's home for women & children experiencing a homeless crisis). 19 parent volunteers shared the task of making the deliveries. Through April 2019, over 10,000 servings of whole/unopened food items (mostly fruits and vegetables) have been rescued and donated to Charis House. In the two school years that SEASCS has been collecting Food Rescue items, we have donated almost 30,000 items to local charities!
